Duties & Responsibilities for the Role

- Actively advocate for equality, diversity and inclusion (ED&I) on campus through various initiatives and events.
- Serve as a liaison between underrepresented student groups and university administration or faculty.
- Voice the concerns and needs of diverse student populations to ensure they are heard and addressed.

- Plan, coordinate, and facilitate workshops, seminars, or cultural events that celebrate diversity and promote inclusivity.
- Provide guidance and support to students from diverse backgrounds, helping them navigate university life.
- Attend training and development sessions related to diversity, leadership, and community engagement.

Special Conditions

Working hours: Work undertaken by Diversity Ambassadors is flexible and fits around your studies.

For this programme, we do expect the majority of ambassadors to work our large-scale events such as International Student Inductions. You are not expected to work every event but are expected to attend if you have committed to do so.
